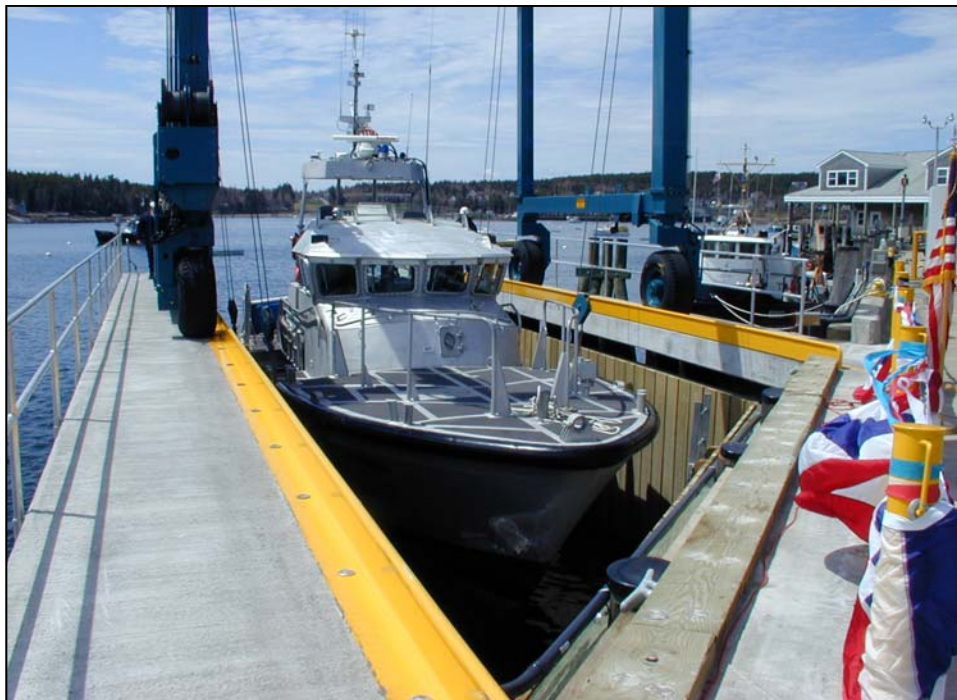


BOAT HAULOUT TRAVEL LIFT PIERS U.S. Coast Guard and Prock Marine Company Southwest Harbor Group Southwest Harbor, ME



Kleinschmidt provided design, calculations, and drawings for design/build contract for new marine travel lift facility at the Southwest Harbor Coast Guard Base. Kleinschmidt was design consultant to the General Contractor, Prock Marine Company of Rockland, Maine. Coast Guard Contract DTCGGI-02-R-3WK189.

The facility is designed to use a 35 ton Travel Lift initially and is capable of supporting a future 50-ton lift. The piers are 60 ft and 90 ft long respectively and utilize steel piles and a concrete deck with a wood wave protection barrier.

Design began in the fall of 2002 and the facility was dedicated in May of 2003.
